

Health Fee

Beginning Fall Semester, 2004, Armstrong Atlantic State University will institute a student health fee that enables the University Health Clinic (UHC) to provide health promotion programs, education, and routine health care. The Health Fee is mandatory for all students. The fee will appear as a line item on your tuition bill. The Student Health Fee is \$13.00 per semester and is charged to all students who take on-campus courses. On-campus courses are defined as any classes taught within Chatham County. This fee is non-refundable.

Examples of clinic services include:

- Assessment and care of minor illnesses
- Medications for acute illnesses
- Preventive medicine and Wellness promotion programs
- STD testing, treatment and counseling
- Diagnostic Testing
- Women's Services
- Meningitis vaccine
- Physical Exams
- Allergy shot administration
- Contraception
- Referrals

The University Health Clinic is designed as a convenient source of primary health care services for AASU students. There may, however, be a time when surgery, more extensive medical treatment, hospitalization, or emergency care is needed. An optional insurance policy, available to all students, is designed to provide backup benefits for some of the services not offered at the University Health Clinic. Although an independent firm provides this coverage, applications and claim forms are available at the University Health Clinic and through the Office of Student Affairs.
