

New Regents' Test Registration System

Armstrong Atlantic State University will be launching a Web-Based Regents' Test Registration System during Advance Registration for spring semester 2005. When students with the appropriate number of credit hours log in to SHIP, they will be automatically routed into a Regents' Test registration window to sign up for the next test session.

The test session will appear on the student's printed schedule, and email notices will be sent to AASU email accounts reminding students of their test date and time. New enforcement policies will also be instituted to require students to attend the test sessions. Any student who does not attend the test will be dropped from pre-registered courses and must re-register during regular registration. Any student who attempts to avoid the test a second time will be required to take the appropriate Reading and Writing Skill classes the subsequent term.

According to the Board of Regents, all University System of Georgia students must take the Regents' Test by their 45th credit hour and transfer students must take the test by their second term of enrollment. Armstrong Atlantic State University has a high rate of non-compliant students who fail to take the Regents' Test on time. Armstrong must do a better job of meeting this requirement so the pass rate is not affected by non-compliance. AASU recognizes that more stringent rules must be instituted and enforced to assure the Board of Regents that we are doing our best to comply with their regulations. The Regents' Test Task Force is convinced this new registration procedure will increase student awareness of this requirement and will ensure a higher compliance and pass rate for our University.

Some students may be exempt from the test based on particular circumstances described in the Regents' test policy located at <http://www.admissions.armstrong.edu/regents/>.
