

AASU STUDENT PARKING DECALS

Students who park their vehicles on the AASU campus must purchase a parking decal. Students may only park in "STUDENT" designated spaces. Funds raised from these sales will be used to pay for new parking, maintenance of current parking, and general parking operations. Decals are issued on an academic year basis and expire August 31st. Student vehicles that do not have appropriate parking decal will be ticketed. The cost and valid dates for each decal is as follows:

Issuing Term	Cost	Valid Time Frame	Available Purchasing Dates
Fall	\$50	September 1 – August 31	June 1 – November 30
Spring	\$25	December 1 – August 31	December 1 – April 30
Summer	\$15	May 1 – August 31	May 1 – July 31

Important Notes: 1) Decals may be transferred ONLY to another vehicle used by the student. 2) Payments for student parking decals are non-refundable. 3) All vehicles must be registered at University Police. 4) This is an elective fee.

PAYMENT PROCESS

Payment may be made using cash, check or credit card. The easiest way to pay is to complete the form below and mail it along with your check to: AASU Student Accounts Office, Student Parking Decals, 11935 Abercorn Street, Savannah, Georgia 31419 or, drop your completed form and check in the payment drop box located in Victor Hall. Payment by cash or check will also be accepted at the cashier's office in Burnett Hall between the hours of 8:30 – 4:30, Monday through Friday. Credit card payments may be made in the lobby of Victor Hall. At the present time, payments may not be made over the web.

Parking decals may be picked up at University Police 5 business days after the Student Accounts Office has received payment. Parking and traffic regulations are available at University Police and on their web site.
